### COURTYARD BY MARRIOTT PHNOM PENH TO SHANGRI-LA PHNOM PENH

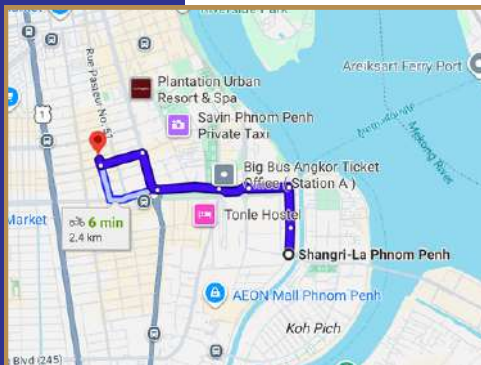

# NEARBY *Cities* TO TRAVEL

## From Phnom Penh To Siem Reap

- Distance: ~320 km (200 miles) between Phnom Penh and Siem Reap.
- By Plane: ~1 hour, fastest option with daily domestic flights.
- By Bus/Minivan: 6-7 hours, affordable and common among budget travelers.
- By Private Taxi/Car: 5-6 hours, more comfort and flexibility.



*Siem Reap is the main entry point to the world-famous Angkor Archaeological Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.*



## From Phnom Penh To Sihanoukville

- Distance: ~ 230 km (143 miles).
- By Train: 6-7 hours, scenic but slower; runs on limited schedules.
- By Bus/Minivan: 5-6 hours, budget-friendly and widely available.
- By Private Taxi/Car: 4-5 hours, faster and more comfortable, with flexible stops.

## From Phnom Penh To Battambang

- Distance: ~290 km (180 miles).
- By Bus/Minivan: 5-6 hours, affordable and the most common choice.
- By Private Taxi/Car: 4-5 hours, faster, more comfortable, and flexible.
- By Train: Currently limited passenger services; not the most practical option.

## From Phnom Penh To Kirirom National Park

- Distance: ~105-114 km (65-71 miles).
- By Bus/Minivan: 2-2.5 hours, around US\$ 10, affordable and common choice.
- By Private Taxi/Car: 1.75-2 hours, about US\$ 70, faster, more comfortable, and flexible.

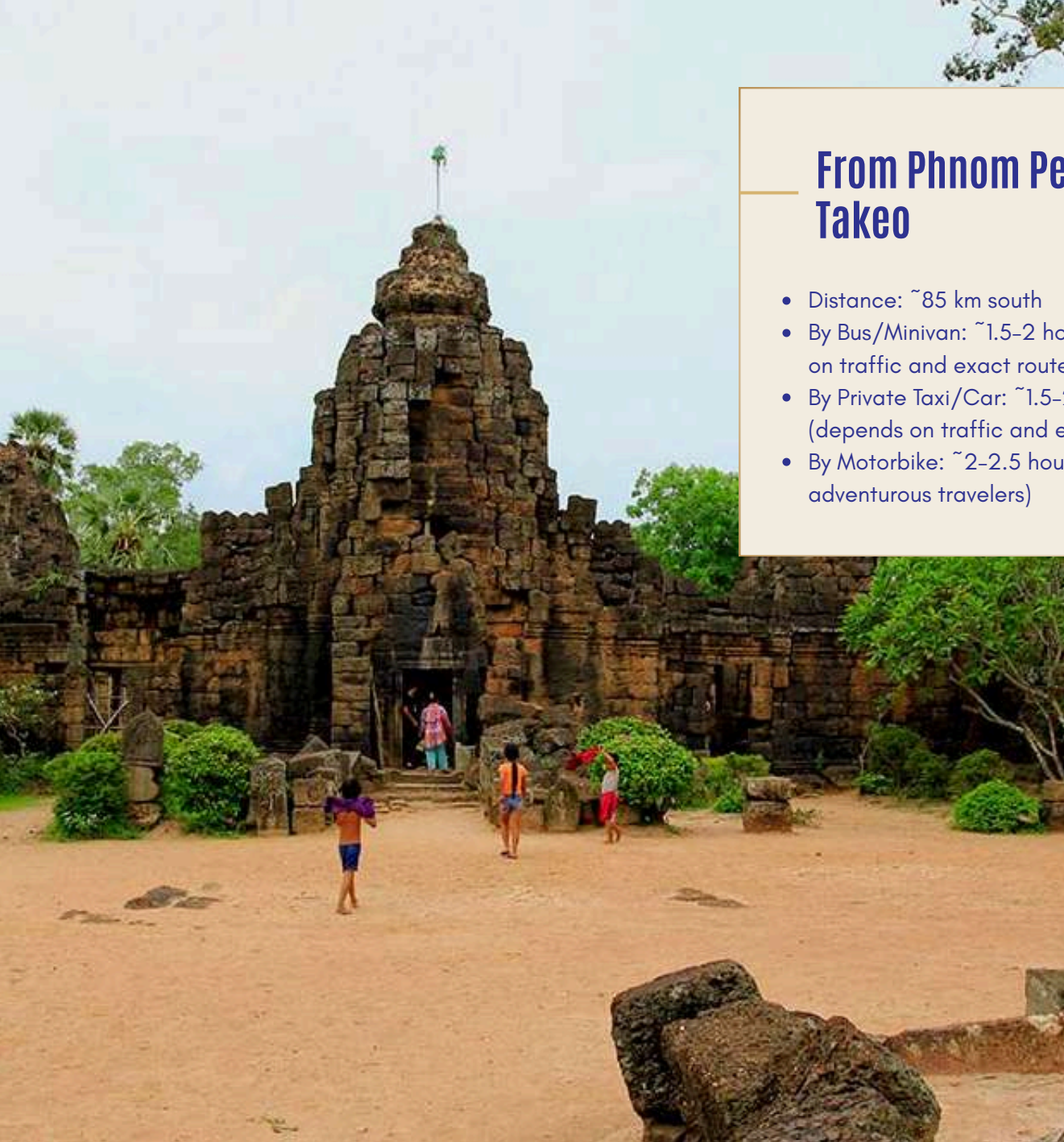

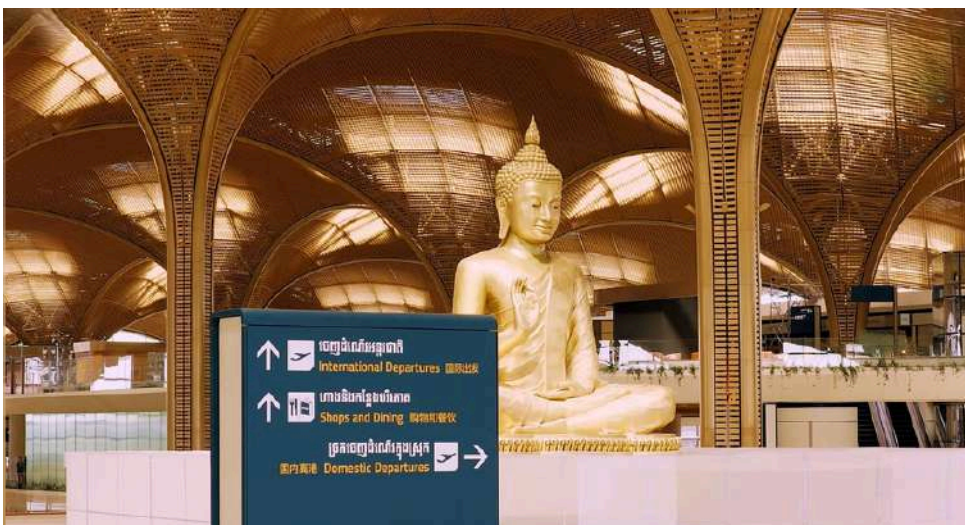

# Techo INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Cambodia's newest aviation hub, officially commenced operations on September 9, 2025, replacing the former Phnom Penh International Airport. Located approximately 20 kilometers south of Phnom Penh in Kandal Province, the airport is designed to serve as a major gateway for both domestic and international flights.



## Techo International Airport (KTI)



It is one of the largest airports in Southeast Asia built from scratch on reclaimed farmland, with a design inspired by Cambodian culture and a strong focus on sustainability, including a solar farm that powers much of the airport's operations.

**01** Choose busy spots – fresher food, faster turnover.

**02** Avoid raw vegetables if you have a sensitive stomach.



**03** Use hand sanitizer before eating.

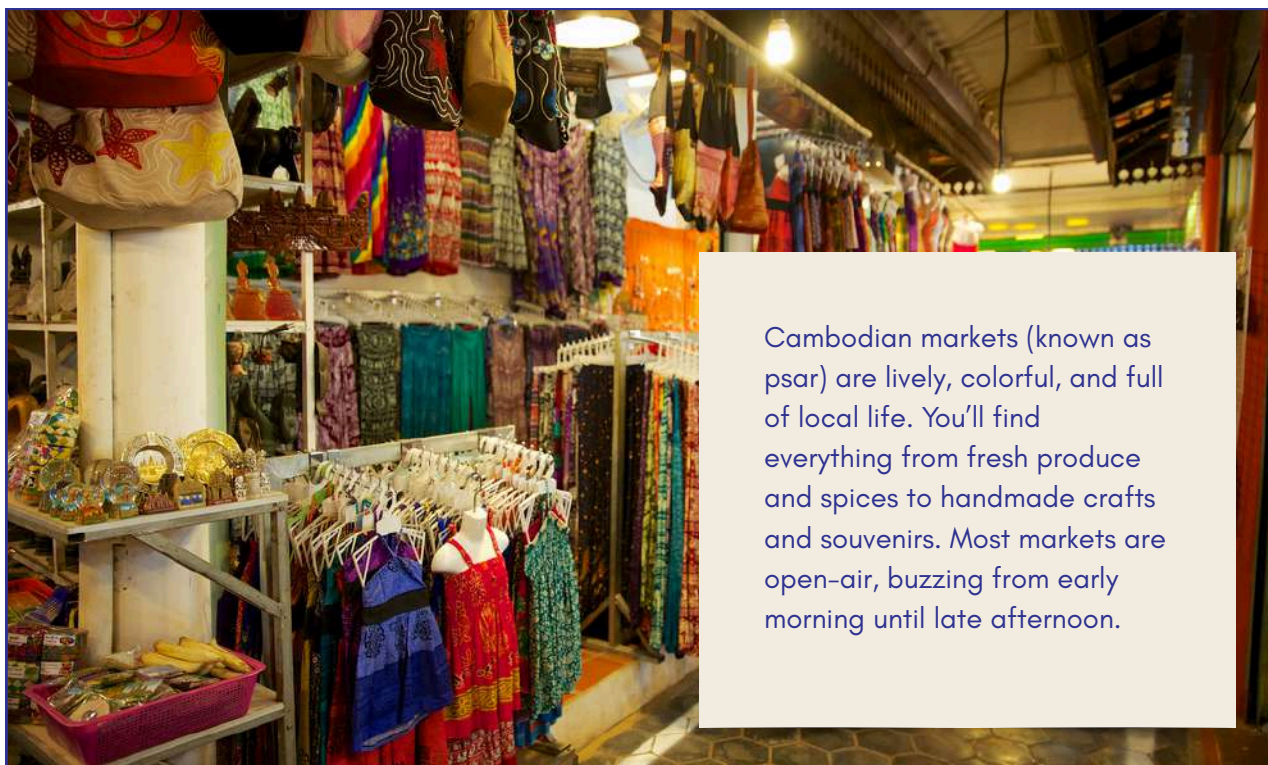
**04** Check the cleanliness of utensils and the dining area.

# TRAVEL ETIQUETTE & SAFETY *Tips*

Respect the culture, stay street-smart

Every city has its own rhythm and unspoken rules. In Cambodia, blending in with local customs and staying aware of your surroundings will make your trip smoother, safer, and more enjoyable.

## Travel Etiquette

Dress modestly when visiting temples or religious sites  
Shoulders and knees should be covered.

Use both hands when giving or receiving items  
Especially with elders or in formal settings – it's a sign of respect.

Avoid raising your voice or showing strong emotions in public  
Cambodian culture values calmness and indirect communication.

Always ask before taking photos of people  
Especially street vendors, elders, or in temples.

Tipping is appreciated but not expected  
Round up the bill at cafés or leave ~10% at restaurants or for tour guides.

## Safety Tips



Use ride-hailing apps like Grab for safe transport

Avoid negotiating on the street unless you're experienced.



Be aware of phone snatchers

Avoid using phones too close to the road or curb.



Watch your bags in crowded areas

Use anti-theft bags or keep backpacks in front of markets.



Drink bottled water

Avoid tap water. Ice is generally safe at established eateries.
